Les intervenants ont pu exposer les problématiques et les solutions trouvées au sein de leurs organisations : Haute École Arc Ingénierie, Tectri, Straumann Villeret, Duotec, Bien-Air, X.Nov, InnoSpina, Bio Science Medical et KA-DEC. Les enjeux liés au sujet brûlant de la mise en œuvre du RDM (règlement européen relatif à la technologie médicale) ont été abordés de nombreuses fois.
